Legal

Investigation of Complaint against Chicago Dentists, Minneapolis, owned by one Korengold who had previously entered a plea of guilty on the 25th of March 1933 to a violation of the dental law. It was contended by the informant that after his plea of guilty, he continued to violate the law by practicing dentistry. Upon investigation by a special investigator it was disclosed to not the fact, and the circumstances and facts did not in the Boards attorneys opinion justify a prosecution.

Re - Carl Redman of Minneapolis

Defendent entered plea of guilty to practicing dentistry without a license in the Municipal Court in the City of Minneapolis, Minn and was sentenced to pay a fine of \$50.00 or forty-five days in the workhouse, Sentence was suspended for a year.

Re - Dr Fiske Brooks

Dr. Brooks was prosecuted for allowing Carl Redman to practice in his office without a license, The defendent appeared in the Municipal Court of Minneapolis Minn and entered a plea of guilty.

Re - Dr. V. Anderson

Investigation and service, with hearing before the Board.

Re - J. A. Waverin

Investigated at Curtis Hotel, Hopkins, Austin, unable to get evidence to convict

Re - Dr. J. L. Deveney

Investigator went to Willow River found Dr. H. W. Clarke operating. Dr Clarke is a licensed dentist, no infraction of the law. Dr Clarke was operating for Dr. J. L. Deveney.

Investigation of a Dr. Anderson at Moose Lake, upon inquiry found that Dr Anderson had gone to Wright, Minn. Investigator went to Wright and asked Dr Anderson to see his license, he stated he had none, he finally admitted his name was Geo Bateman, The deputy Sheriff of Pine City, Pine Co wher the offence was committed placed Bateman in custody, he was then taken before the Justice of Peace and fined \$25.00 and costs.

Re - Bloomington-Lake Clinic

Complaint that Frank Lambert was operating there could not get any evidence that Lambert was operating. Lambert is an old offender and the Sheriffs office was notified of Lamberts whereabouts as he is wanted on committment to Stillwater.

Investigated Nicollet Dental Clinic Re - ~~Dr~~ Christianson could find no evidence of his operating.

Re - Dr. Charles Davies

Complaint against Dr Davies found to be groundless. Dr. Davies was practising within the law and had his Certificate of Registration properly posted in his office.

Report to Governor of Minnesota

In compliance with Section 5758 Dental law enacted March 1927. The Board made a report of its proceedings and the items of its receipts and disbursements to Hon Floyd B. Olson.
