Minnesota Statutes, section 14.05, subdivision 5, directs the Minnesota Department of Employment and Economic Development to report to you by December 1 of each year whether any of its rules are obsolete, unnecessary, or duplicative of other state or federal rules.

DEED is in the process of formal rulemaking to amend portions of Chapters 3300.2005 to 3300.2055. DEED is currently drafting a Statement of Need and Reasonableness, which will provide a more in-depth analysis of the proposed changes to Chapters 3300.2005 to 3300.2055.
