December 1 of each year whether any of its rules are obsolete, unnecessary, or duplicative of other state or federal statutes or rules.

The board has previously declared its intention to address obsolete rules; that process is underway as part of the board's major rules overhaul focused primarily on the licensing of individuals, salons, and schools, and the operations of salons.

The Board has reviewed its rules and found *Minnesota Rules 2105.0100* and *Minnesota Rules 2110.0100, Subpart 1* to be obsolete, and plans to address these rules in the current rule process underway.
