#### Services offered to the community include:

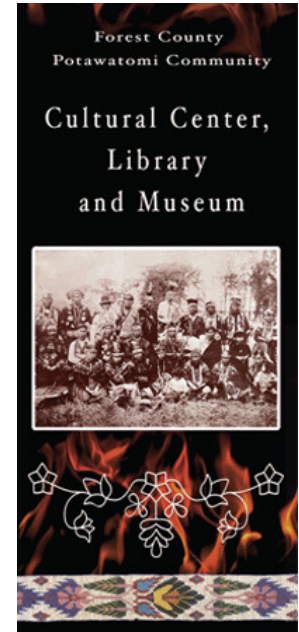
- Language and cultural class instruction

The Forest County Potawatomi Library is a tribally-owned and operated public library. Our collection focuses exclusively on Native Studies, with an emphasis on the Potawatomi Nation and the tribes of the Great Lakes region. We also have a non-circulating research library which consists of reference materials and a rare book collection. We are located in the upper level of the Museum building.

#### Circulation Policy

Books and CD's are loaned for four weeks and may be renewed twice by phone/e-mail. (Total borrowing time of 3 months.)

Videos and DVD's are loaned for one week. Educational titles are free. Entertainment titles are \$3 per week. Movies may be renewed twice by phone/e-mail, but the borrower will incur the additional weekly charge for entertainment titles. (Total borrowing time of 3 weeks.)
