Proclamation

- WHEREAS: On Friday, November 13, 2015, terrible acts of violence were committed against innocent civilians in Paris, France; and
- WHEREAS: The victims and their families deserve our honor, respect, and remembrance; and
- WHEREAS: The President of the United States of America has lowered United States flags at all public buildings, grounds, and military posts of the Federal Government until sunset on Thursday, November 19, 2015.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARK DAYTON, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby order all United States flags and Minnesota flags be flown at half-staff at all state and federal buildings in the State of Minnesota immediately, until sunset on Thursday, November 19, 2015, in memory of the victims of this tragedy.
