Proclamation

- WHEREAS: The manufacturing industry is a dynamic segment of Minnesota's economy, an important driver of quality of life, and an integral part of the state's economic development strategy; and
- WHEREAS: In 2013, manufacturing had the second largest total payroll among business sectors in Minnesota, providing \$18.3 billion; and
- WHEREAS: In 2013, manufacturing contributed \$43.7 billion to Minnesota's economy, and produced the largest share of the gross domestic product at 16 percent; and
- WHEREAS: In 2013, manufacturing exports brought \$20.7 billion into Minnesota's economy; and
- WHEREAS: Manufacturing provides skilled, high-paying jobs, which significantly contribute to Minnesota's high standard of living and economic vitality.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARK DAYTON, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of October 19-25, 2014, as:

MANUFACTURERS' WEEK

in the State of Minnesota.
