Proclamation

- WHEREAS: A healthy mouth is key to overall health, and oral health is critical to the health and wellness of the State of Minnesota; and
- WHEREAS: The Minnesota Mission of Mercy was established in 2012 to provide free dental care, especially to patients with dental infections or pain; and
- WHEREAS: The Minnesota Mission of Mercy raises awareness of the barriers to dental care faced by low income children and adults, and serves the immediate dental care of thousands of Minnesotans; and
- WHEREAS: More than 1,000 dental professionals and volunteers from across Minnesota will gather in Duluth on July 17th and July 18th 2015, to provide free dental care to children and adults in need; and
- WHEREAS: About one million dollars in free dental care and invaluable oral health education will be provided to patients during this two day event.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARK DAYTON, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Friday, July 17, 2015, as:
