Minnesota Statutes, section 14.05, subdivision 5, directs agencies to report to you by December 1 of each year whether any of its rules are obsolete, unnecessary, or duplicative of other state or federal statutes or rules.

The Minnesota Gambling Control Board is currently promulgating rules. Minnesota Rules, part 7861.0210, subpart 33a, definition of local server, is being repealed because it will be obsolete and unnecessary by adoption of these rules. There are no other obsolete, unnecessary, or duplicative references in rule.
