Proclamation

WHEREAS: On Thursday, September 18, 2014, the Minnesota Section of the American Society of Civil Engineers is celebrating the 100 year anniversary of its founding at a gala event at the University of Minnesota, St. Anthony Falls Hydraulics Laboratory; and
