- WHEREAS: The Minnesota State Academy for the Deaf is nationally recognized as one of the outstanding schools for the deaf in the United States; and
- WHEREAS: The Minnesota State Academy for the Deaf has maintained high standards among its staff and in methods of education; and
- WHEREAS: Since its establishment in 1863 by the Minnesota Legislature, the Minnesota State Academy for the Deaf has educated more than 4,500 children who have become independent and self-supporting citizens.
