# Proclamation

WHEREAS: On February 16, 1965, a request was authorized and submitted to the Legislature of the State of Minnesota to approve the consolidation of the town of Inver Grove and the village of Inver Grove to be known as the City of Inver Grove Heights; and

WHEREAS: Fifty years have passed since the City of Inver Grove Heights was first recognized as a separate government entity; and

WHEREAS: Through the efforts of residents, city officials, and staff, the City maintains an enduring commitment to providing excellent services and the highest quality of life for its residents; and

WHEREAS: This commitment is demonstrated through the City's planning and vision for the future regarding commercial development, housing, transportation, parks and recreation, and public works infrastructure; as well as strong financial planning, administrative leadership, and police and fire protection for its residents; and

WHEREAS: The City fosters community health by supporting and staffing the Veterans Memorial Community Center as well as a number of other recreational venues; and

WHEREAS: Residents, city officials, and staff will gather together to commemorate the occasion on Monday, December 7, 2015 with a ceremonial tree lighting event at the Veterans Memorial Community Center.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARK DAYTON, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of December 7-12, 2015, as:
