Proclamation

WHEREAS: On average, 700 people die each year in boating-related accidents in the U.S.; approximately 70 percent of these are fatalities caused by drowning; and

WHEREAS: The vast majority of these accidents are caused by human error or poor judgement and not by the boat, equipment, or environmental factors; and

WHEREAS: A significant number of boaters who lose their lives by drowning each year would be alive today had they worn life jackets; and

WHEREAS: Today's life jackets are more comfortable, more attractive, and more wearable than styles of years past and deserve a fresh look by today's boating public.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARK DAYTON, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of May 21-27, 2016, as:

SAFE BOATING WEEK

in the State of Minnesota.
