- WHEREAS: Minnesota's state fair is known for its wide assortment of food, both classic and creative, including tasty choices like Pronto Pups, cheese curds, deep-fried candy bars, and all other conceivable fried foods on-a-stick; and
- WHEREAS: The Minnesota State Fair has provided generations of Minnesotans, young and old, an opportunity to get together for twelve days of summer fun.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARK DAYTON, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Thursday, August 25, 2016, as:
