WHEREAS: Only 50 percent of those babies survived; and

WHEREAS: CDH is as common as spina bifida and cystic fibrosis; however very few people know

about it or are aware of it; and

WHEREAS: 1,600 babies are born with CDH every year in the United States; and

WHEREAS: There are many people living in Minnesota who have been diagnosed with and have

survived CDH; although many families in Minnesota have endured the horrible pain and grief associated with the loss of loved ones with CDH; and

WHEREAS: Those with CDH often undergo multiple surgeries and experience medical complication

intestinal problems, developmental delays, and may require respiratory and medicinal beyond their diagnosis that include heart defects, pulmonary complications, gastric and

support for years; and

WHEREAS: Raising awareness of this congenital defect will help bring about acceptance and support

for those suffering with CDH and will help advocate for urgently needed medical

research and advances.
