- WHEREAS: All Minnesotans rely on clean drinking water from public water systems in their homes, schools, and workplaces; and
- WHEREAS: Minnesota is committed to ensuring public water supplies are safe and reliable.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARK DAYTON, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of May 7-13, 2017, as:
