Proclamation

WHEREAS: Arthrogyrosis multiplex congenital (AMC) is a condition from birth of multiple joint contractures, which leads to abnormal muscle development and muscle weakness; and

WHEREAS: AMC is classified as a rare disorder; it nevertheless affects 1 in 3000 live births; and

WHEREAS: AMC has no known cure, although studies have led to several treatment methods, such as physical therapy and bracing; and

WHEREAS: The State of Minnesota recognizes the need to raise awareness of arthrogyrosis multiplex congenital in an effort to facilitate an early diagnosis and find a cure.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARK DAYTON, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Friday, June 30, 2017, as:

ARTHROGRYPOSIS MULTIPLEX CONGENITA AWARENESS DAY

in the State of Minnesota.
