Proclamation

- WHEREAS: There are a limited amount of resources, both human and physical, available to meet public demand for facilities, programs, and services; and
- WHEREAS: Full use of existing public facilities, programs, and services is a desirable community goal; and
- WHEREAS: Community education enables full use of public facilities, programs, and services by every age group in the community; and
- WHEREAS: Community education philosophy assumes that when local communities identify their own needs and resources, and public agencies work cooperatively, communities will thrive; and
- WHEREAS: Agency coordination and cooperation, and the involvement of local communities improves public services and is essential to the development of community education programs; and
- WHEREAS: "Community Education Day" will be celebrated throughout Minnesota and the United States on Thursday, November 9, 2017.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARK DAYTON, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Thursday, November 9, 2017, as:

COMMUNITY EDUCATION DAY

in the State of Minnesota.
