

# SNAPSHOT | Investing in Infrastructure Across Minnesota

*2018 Public Works Bill for a Better Minnesota*

Governor Dayton’s \$1.5 billion public works proposal would make urgently-needed investments to build world-class colleges and universities for Minnesotans, and improve and repair state buildings and other critical infrastructure across the state. The Governor’s proposal would invest \$541 million at the University of Minnesota and Minnesota State campuses. An additional \$996 million would be directed to improving state buildings, building affordable housing, repairing clean water infrastructure, and other infrastructure projects across Minnesota. This snapshot breaks down projects that would be completed under Governor Dayton’s public works proposal, sorted by county.
