WHEREAS: Minnesotans are grateful for the service, accomplishments, and sacrifices of Vietnam War veterans; and

WHEREAS: It is never too late to pay tribute to and honor those who answered our nation's call in Vietnam; and

WHEREAS: It is appropriate and just to recognize the achievements of our Minnesota Vietnam veterans, and thank them for their sacrifices and service provided in the name of our country.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARK DAYTON, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Thursday, March 29, 2018, as:
