- WHEREAS: By working together to increase knowledge of the needs and responsibilities of all roads and highway users, while encouraging users to exercise added caution, we strive to make our roads safer, thereby enabling motorcyclists throughout Minnesota to have an enjoyable riding season.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARK DAYTON, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of May 2018 as:
