Proclamation

- WHEREAS: The Minnesota State USBC (United States Bowling Congress) Association promotes the development of bowling opportunities for adults and youth through its 45,000 members in the State of Minnesota; and
- WHEREAS: The Minnesota State USBC believes that participation in the sport of bowling promotes healthy living through exercise and the pursuit of excellence; and
- WHEREAS: The Minnesota State USBC supports Minnesota Veterans through the Bowlers to Veterans Link (BVL), and supports the fight against breast cancer through Bowl for the Cure, in partnership with the Susan G. Komen Foundation; and
- WHEREAS: The Minnesota State USBC will begin their bowling week on Saturday, August 4, 2018 by hosting the 51st Annual Minnesota State USBC Bowling Jamboree, including the Matt Lang Youth Scholarship Tournament with a Jr. Gold Qualifier at Mermaid Lanes in Moundsview, MN. Winners of the event will receive scholarship dollars; and
- WHEREAS: Minnesota State USBC members will have the opportunity to enhance their bowling skills through classroom instruction and on-lanes coaching clinics on August 4, 2018; and
- WHEREAS: The Minnesota State USBC promotes bowling as both an individual sport and team sport, and encourages the lifelong enjoyment of bowling among families and friends.
