- WHEREAS: Town ball has been played in communities across Minnesota for decades — having been played since at least the 1920s — to the delight of countless generations; and
- WHEREAS: Today, this proud baseball tradition continues with nearly 300 active town ball teams across Minnesota playing in over 30 leagues statewide; and
- WHEREAS: The level of teamwork and discipline, both physical and mental, demanded by baseball are qualities that are helpful to all participants, whatever their other endeavors may be; and
- WHEREAS: The Minnesota State Amateur Baseball Tournament provides a wholesome outlet for players and spectators who love the exciting sport of baseball; and
- WHEREAS: The 95th Annual Minnesota State Amateur Baseball Tournament is being held in New Prague, Shakopee, and Jordan from August 17, 2018, through September 3, 2018.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARK DAYTON, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim August 17- September 3, 2018, as:
