WHEREAS: The protection and continuation of progress for full equality in Minnesota and the nation is vital, to ensure that all lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, and queer Americans can be open, honest, and safe at home, at work, at school, and in the community; and

WHEREAS: It is fitting that Minnesotans honor and congratulate all who serve in the cause of securing human rights for the lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, and queer community.
