- WHEREAS: Central Service Department tasks include decontaminating, cleaning, processing, assembling, sterilizing, storing, and distributing the medical devices and supplies needed for patient care; and
- WHEREAS: The Central Service Department of a healthcare facility is the heart of all activity surrounding instruments, supplies, and equipment required for operating rooms, Endoscopy suites, intensive care units, birth centers, and other patient care areas; and
- WHEREAS: Central Service Technicians play an important role in patient care, and are responsible for first-line processes to prevent patient infections; and
- WHEREAS: International Central Service Week recognizes the contributions that Central Service Technicians make to patient safety, and the opportunities and challenges facing the profession.
