- WHEREAS: We also recognize the need for greater understanding of the cultural depth of the traditional practices of American Indians and the need to preserve this heritage by sharing and learning through cultural exchanges; and
- WHEREAS: The American Indian community seeks to celebrate its tribal heritage and commemorate its ancestors and future generations through presenting and participating in cultural events and exchanging dialogues with citizens throughout the month of May.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARK DAYTON, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of May, 2012 as:

AMERICAN INDIAN MONTH

in the State of Minnesota.
