WHEREAS: The citizens of our state have worked hard to improve human relations, and the lesbian, gay, bisexual, and transgender community of Minnesota has contributed substantially to the quality of life and success of this region; and

WHEREAS: The past year's successful movement to gain equality for citizens regardless of their sexual orientation or gender identity is cause for celebration;

WHEREAS: The fight for human rights in Minnesota and the Nation must continue in order to ensure that all lesbian, gay, bisexual, and transgender Americans can be open, honest, and safe at home, at work, at school, and in the community; and

WHEREAS: It is fitting that Minnesotans honor and congratulate all who serve in the cause of securing human rights for the lesbian, gay, bisexual, and transgender community.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARK DAYTON, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Saturday, September 6, 2014, as:

HUMAN RIGHTS CAMPAIGN DAY

in the State of Minnesota.
