- WHEREAS: Lung cancer is the leading cause of death from cancer worldwide; and
- WHEREAS: Every three minutes, someone loses their battle with lung cancer; and
- WHEREAS: Lung cancer patients face the same physical, emotional, and financial hardships as those with any other cancer or major disease; and
- WHEREAS: Lung cancer patients battle and experience the same fears, depression, losses and grueling treatments as those with other cancers and major diseases; and
- WHEREAS: Lung cancer patients often isolate themselves due to the stigma attached to the disease; and
- WHEREAS: Lung cancer patients need compassion, support, and recognition.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARK DAYTON, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Friday, August 1, 2014, as:

LUNG CANCER DAY

in the State of Minnesota.
