- WHEREAS: The Midwest Comic Book Association has donated over 250,000 age appropriate comic books to local schools, hospitals, and libraries; and
- WHEREAS: The Midwest Comic Book Association brings professionals, creators, dealers, and fans to Minnesota from across the United States for biannual events; and
- WHEREAS: The 25th anniversary of the Midwest Comic Book Association is being celebrated at the Minnesota State Fair Grandstand from May 18 – 19, 2013.
