Proclamation

- WHEREAS: Team Braemar is Minnesota's most decorated and successful junior synchronized skating team, representing the Braemar-City of Lakes Figure Skating Club in Edina, Minnesota; and
- WHEREAS: Team Braemar, coached by Pam May and Toni Swiggum, will skate their final performances of the season on April 27 and April 28, 2012 at the Braemar-City of Lakes Figure Skating Club's 47th Annual Ice Show; and
- WHEREAS: Team Braemar is considered one of the world's elite junior level synchronized skating teams. In 2012, Team Braemar competed on behalf of Team USA for the sixth consecutive year, placing fourth in a field of eighteen teams, representing thirteen countries, at the Junior World Challenge Cup competition in Gothenburg, Sweden; and
- WHEREAS: Team Braemar is the current national, junior champion and consistently places with top honors, nationally and internationally; and
- WHEREAS: The members of Team Braemar represent 15 different Minnesota high schools, and have demonstrated the dedication, determination, and sportsmanship required to succeed at a high level of athletic competition, while maintaining academic excellence.
