- WHEREAS: Minnesota's youth make important contributions to the wellbeing of their communities and the state every day of the year through service and service learning; and
- WHEREAS: Most people who volunteer as youth continue serving throughout their lives; and
- WHEREAS: The State of Minnesota depends on youth as vital community assets for their skills, perspective, and creativity; and
- WHEREAS: Global Youth Service Day, a program of Youth Service America, is one of the largest service events in the world, and will be observed April 26 – 28, 2013; and
- WHEREAS: Global Youth Service Day provides an opportunity for schools, community and faith-based organizations, government agencies, and businesses to engage youth as active citizens; and
- WHEREAS: Lead agencies for Global Youth Service Day include the Minnesota Alliance with Youth and the Minnesota Family, Career, and Community Leaders of America.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARK DAYTON, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim
April 26 – 28, 2013 as:
