Proclamation

- WHEREAS: The Capitol Area Library Consortium (CALCO) was formed in 1973 to develop a strong network of state government libraries, librarians, and library staff to better serve the information needs of their organizations; and
- WHEREAS: CALCO has worked to achieve greater collaboration, efficiency, and information access within state government through participation in Minitex, a statewide resource-sharing network; and PALS, a statewide integrated library system; and
- WHEREAS: CALCO provides a strong network for state government libraries, librarians, and library staff that includes online communication, regular meetings, and opportunities for professional development and public outreach; and
- WHEREAS: CALCO librarians and library staff work cooperatively to promote and enhance library services in state government by developing, managing, and preserving unique and diverse collections of resources; and
- WHEREAS: Celebrating its 40th year, the Capitol Area Library Consortium's 13 member libraries and four associate members continue to strive for convenient access to state government library resources for state employees, local government officials, Minnesota citizens, and other libraries nationwide.
