Proclamation

WHEREAS: World Elder Abuse Awareness Day (WEAAD) was launched on June 15, 2006, by the International Network for the Prevention of Elder Abuse and the World Health Organization at the United Nations; and

WHEREAS: The purpose of WEAAD is to provide an opportunity for communities around the world to promote a better understanding of abuse and neglect of older persons by raising awareness of the cultural, social, economic, and demographic processes affecting elder abuse and neglect; and

WHEREAS: In Minnesota and throughout the world abuse, neglect, and financial exploitation of elders and vulnerable adults is under-recognized; and

WHEREAS: On June 12, 2014, Minnesota will recognize the ninth anniversary of World Elder Abuse Awareness Day with a full day of speakers and presentations related to financial exploitation and other forms of elder abuse.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARK DAYTON, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Sunday, June 15, 2014, as:

ELDER ABUSE AWARENESS DAY

in the State of Minnesota.
