- WHEREAS: The Health Care Auxiliary of Minnesota (HCAM) represents more than 21,400 volunteers who serve at 95 hospitals and aging services care centers across Minnesota; and
- WHEREAS: Health care volunteers in Minnesota served more than 1.4 million hours in 2012, valued at more than \$32.5 million dollars; and
- WHEREAS: Health care volunteers raised more than \$5.5 million dollars in 2012 to improve the quality of health care in the communities where they live and serve; and
- WHEREAS: Health care volunteers advocate on behalf of the health and well-being of the citizens of Minnesota.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARK DAYTON, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim
Wednesday, April 9, 2014, as:
