

Key Notes:

- This grant is administered by Second Harvest Heartland on behalf of the six Feeding America food banks who serve MN. Each food bank is responsible for distributing the food to the counties they serve.
- The milk funds are allocated up front to food banks based on food insecurity rates in the counties they serve. Milk is procured by each food bank separately. Both Second Harvest Heartland and Channel One Food Bank spent their entire milk grant allocations by the end of Q1. The remaining food banks traditionally wait until October to begin using their milk grant allocations.
- Approximately 155,372 gallons of milk have been distributed to the community with the grant funds spent throughout the grant year.



Key Notes:

- Approximately 1,349 gallons of milk have been distributed to the community with the grant funds spent during Q4.
- In Q4 11 agencies were served across 3 Minnesota counties.
- In Q4, only Great Plains Food Bank and Northern Lakes Food Bank had grant funds remaining to be spent on milk.
- While most cluster members source their milk from Kemps, Great Plains Food Bank sources milk from Land O'Lakes.
