RE: Department of Military Affairs Emergency Services Open Appropriation FY 2024 Year-end Report (M.S. 192.52)

Dear Senator Marty and Representative Torkelson:

Attached please find the FY 2024 year-end report of expenditures and reimbursements related to the Department of Military Affairs' Emergency Services open appropriation. This report includes expenditures and eligibility for reimbursements from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) and eligibility for reimbursements under the State of Minnesota's Emergency Management Assistance Compact (EMAC). Two missions (under Executive Orders 24-04 and 24-05) were completed in FY 2024. Two other missions (under Executive Orders 20-64 and 21-06) either continued into or had additional expenditures in FY 2024; for these two missions, this is an interim report.

The provisions of M.S. 192.52 require that "...when the active service has been completed, the commissioner of management and budget shall report the actual cost to the Committee on Finance of the Senate and the Committee on Ways and Means of the House of Representatives." This report is issued to meet this requirement.
