

**SECOND AMENDMENT TO  
TECHNICAL STANDARDS IN  
TRIBAL-STATE COMPACT FOR CONTROL OF  
CLASS III BLACKJACK ON THE  
LOWER SIOUX COMMUNITY  
RESERVATION IN MINNESOTA**

Pursuant to Section 7 of the Tribal-State Compact for Control of Class III Blackjack on the Lower Sioux Indian Community Reservation in Minnesota (hereinafter "Community"), the State of Minnesota, by and through its Commissioner of Public Safety, and the Community agree as follows:

1. Section 4.5(6)(K) is deleted and replaced with the following language:


"At any time when all players leave the table and prior to play resuming, the cards shall be spread out face upwards on the table for visual inspection by the first player or players to arrive at the table. Upon request by the first player or players, the cards shall be spread out in horizontal fan shaped columns by deck according to suit and in sequence."
