

FIRST AMENDMENT TO
TECHNICAL STANDARDS IN
TRIBAL-STATE COMPACT FOR CONTROL OF
CLASS III BLACKJACK ON THE
UPPER SIOUX COMMUNITY RESERVATION IN MINNESOTA

Pursuant to section 7 of the Tribal-State Compact for Control of Class III Blackjack on the Upper Sioux Community Reservation in Minnesota (hereinafter "Community"), the State of Minnesota, by and through its Commissioner of Public Safety, and the Community agree as follows:

1. Section 4.5(2)A is deleted and replaced with the following language:

(2) Cards; Number of Decks; Value of Cards:


A. Blackjack shall be played with at least one non-bordered deck of cards with backs of the same color and design and one colored cutting card. Before being put into play, the cards shall arrive at the gaming location sealed and wrapped.


