

**AMENDMENT TO TECHNICAL STANDARDS IN
TRIBAL-STATE COMPACT FOR CONTROL OF
CLASS III BLACKJACK ON THE
WHITE EARTH BAND OF CHIPPEWA
RESERVATION IN MINNESOTA**

Pursuant to Section 7 of the Tribal-State Compact for Control of Class III Blackjack on the White Earth Band of Chippewa Reservation in Minnesota (hereinafter "Band"), the State of Minnesota, by and through its Commission of Public Safety, and the Band agree as follows:

Section 4.5(2)A of the amended Compact (dated October 25, 2000) which reads:

Blackjack shall be played with at least one non-bordered deck of cards with backs of the same color and design and on colored cutting card. Before being put into play, the cards shall arrive at the gaming location sealed and wrapped.

Is hereby deleted and replaced with the following language:

"Blackjack shall be played with at least one bordered or non-bordered deck of cards with backs of the same color and design and one colored cutting card. Before being put into play, the cards shall arrive at the gaming location sealed and wrapped."
