**ITEM F: BRIEF SUMMARY OF BOARD RULES PROPOSED OR ADOPTED DURING THIS REPORTING PERIOD, FY 75 AND FY 76. GIVE APPROPRIATE CITATIONS TO THE STATE REGISTER AND PUBLISHED RULES FOR THOSE ADOPTED.**

Proposed changes in Minnesota Statutes regulating boxing - February 3, 1975 Meeting.

1-2-3-4-5-6 and #5 the added amendment

1. MSA 341.06 Section 5 Subd.2 - Delete last sentence which reads as follows:  
"Provided that no person licensed to promote or conduct boxing or sparring exhibitions shall directly or indirectly engage in the managing of any boxer".
2. MSA 341.06 - Change \$20,000.00 to \$40,000.00
3. MSA 341.06 Section 4 - Change \$6,000.00 to \$12,000.00
4. MSA 341.03 - Change \$35.00 for each meeting to \$50.00 for each meeting.
5. MSA 341.10 Section 11 - Change to read: The Commission shall make rules and regulations to govern the holding of Amateur Boxing Exhibitions within the State, and DELETE balance of the section which requires the rules to govern to the rules of the American Amateur Athletic Union.
6. MSA 341.14 Section 18 - Change payment to the Commission to payment to the treasurer.

ADDITIONAL STATUTORY CHANGE

1. MSA 341.10 - Shall be amended to add after "license all boxers, managers, seconds, and referees and judges".

After some discussion on AC changes 1,2,3,4,5,6 changed but #7 to be scratched. Also adopted the Additional changes in AC 26 Subd.3 and AC 39 and Subd.B

1. AC 9 - Change from payable to the Commission to payable to the Treasurer
2. AC 11 - Change 12 tickets to 16 tickets and change "not more than 10 elsewhere" to "not more than 30 elsewhere".
3. AC 18 - DELETE "no refreshments, drinks of whatever description - popcorn or other edibles".
4. AC 24 - DELETE in entirety (promoter--manager).
5. AC 25 - DELETE "No partial licenses shall be issued".
6. AC 26 (b) Subd.3 - Change to read as follows: "For a violation of the State Law, or any rule covering boxing in the State of Minnesota, any member of the Commission, or the Secretary, shall have the authority to temporarily suspend any boxer, second or manager, until such time as the Commission may consider the matter or see fit to reinstate, and that this Commission, being a member of the World Boxing Association, shall recognize and concur with all suspensions issued by the World

At the February 3, 1975 Commission Meeting there were changes in Rules and Regulations of the Boxing Commission as follows:

**AC 23 PROMOTERS**

- (a) Strike out part of last sentence  
(for at least 6 mos. and may be liable to a lifetime suspension).

**AC 24 DELETE**

**AC 39 REFEREE**

- (a) Strike out part (In the City of Duluth etc.)

Add instead:

In all other Cities outside of St. Paul and Minneapolis, it shall be optional with the Boxing Commission.

- (l) In last sentence Strike out shall and put will declare him the loser
- (r) In last sentence Referee may or will cease counting etc.

**AC 44 Last sentence:**

Boxers failing to appear for weighing and examination at the time prescribed by the Club or Commission ~~must be reported to the Commission~~ may be fined.

**AC 45 TIMEKEEPER**

- (a) Add "a timekeeper" (not two)
- (b) There be a Knockdown Judge seated next to the Timekeeper.
- (c) The "Timekeeper" shall indicate the beginning and ending of each round by striking the gong with a metal hammer.
- (d) ok
- (e) The Knockdown judge shall begin his count when the contestant is knocked down.

AC 51 The last sentence Deleted. This motion by Commissioner Allen, Second by Commissioner Dauphin - Passed.

**AC 52 DELETE**

AC 60 18 years - 10 rounds okay

AC 62 DELETE all after word exhibition

AC 65 DELETE "except in cities other than those of the first class, twenty-four shall suffice".

AC 68 DELETE after "contest" ADD "a Commissioner may bar him".

1. AC 26 Subd.3 - Add after "Suspend any boxer, second or manager or referee or judge.
2. AC 39 Referee Subd.A - Amend to read as follows: "The chief official of the contest shall be the Referee who shall have general supervision of bouts and shall take his position in the ring. All bouts held in Minnesota shall be to a decision. The decision shall be made by the Referee and two judges scored on a 10 point system and the men who act as judges shall be licensed Referees, except that when none are available, the Commission shall appoint a judge or judges to act with the Referee in scoring the decision. Said judges shall be seated at the ringside opposite each other". Subd.B - Amend to read as follows: "The Referee - and Judges - for all contests shall be assigned by the Commission".
