(a) Services Provided

The department provides for the accounting and reporting of all revenues and disbursements made by state agencies. It provides comprehensive, timely and accurate financial information for all state agencies and is capable of providing daily reports of revenues, expenditure, cash balances and outstanding obligations. Another service provided by this department is developing and modifying the biennial budget system, statewide accounting system, payroll and position control, inventory and purchasing and report development.

(b) A-87 Allowable Cost Standard

"The cost of establishing and maintaining accounting and other information systems required for the management of grant programs is allowable. This includes cost incurred by central service agencies for these purposes. . ." "The cost of disbursing grant program funds by the Treasurer or other designated officer is allowable. Disbursing services cover the processing of checks or warrants, from preparation to redemption, including the necessary records of accountability and reconcilitation of such records with related cash accounts."

(c) Allocable Services

All of the Finance operations are allocable.

(d) Allocation Base

Number of transactions processed for each agency as a percent

of transactions processed for all state agencies. Controller's

salaries are distributed separately based on the number of tran
sactions in the agencies with which each is concerned.

STATE OF MINNESOTA PERSONNEL DEPARTMENT

(a) Services Provided

The Personnel Department performs the central personnel management function for the executive branch of Minnesota State government. It is the State's chief recruiting, examining, training selection and placement agency. It classifies positions for uniformity, conducts salary studies and establishes pay rates. The department maintains personnel records and certifies employees hourly rates.

(b) A-87 Allowable Cost Standard

"Costs for the recruitment, examination, certification, classification, training, performance appraisal, job classification, extablishment of pay standards and related activities for grant programs, are allowable."

(c) Allocable Services

All of the services of the Personnel Department are allocable.

(d) Allocation Base

The base to allocate Personnel costs is the number of employees by State Agency.

STATE OF MINNESOTA PERSONNEL DEPARTMENT SOCIAL SECURITY AND INSURANCE ADMIN.

(a) Service Provided

This division of employee benefits of the Department of Personnel tabulates, audits, and records, Social Security collections from wage record reports received from participating governmental units i.e., State agencies, counties, municipalities and school districts, for submission to federal offices. It conducts referenda on Social Security upon request. Another function of the division of employee benefits is the administration of State employees hospitalization, major medical and life insurance programs. It researches alternative insurance programs and negotiates contracts. Billings to State agencies are audited and questionable claims reviewed. It also provides advise and assistance to the Commissioner of Personnel and the State Labor Negotiator.

(b) A-87 Allocable Cost Standard

"Employee benefits in the form of employers' contributions or expenses for Social Security, Employees' Life and Health Infurance plans. . . ."

(c) Allocable Services

All of the administration of State employees insurance and that portion of Social Security administration applicable to State agencies is allocable.

(d) Allocation Base

Costs are allocated to users based upon the number of employees by agency.

STATE OF MINNESOTA HIGHER EDUCATION COORDINATING COMMISSION

It is composed of two groups - the Commission itself and the staff of the Commission. The Commission represents the various State education systems, private colleges and the general public.

(a) Services Provided.

The Commission incurs little expense and is primarily a forum and policy setting body. The staff performs research for the Commission and administers programs and funds authorized by the State Legislature for scholarships, educational T.V. and facilities.

(b) A-87 Allocable Cost Standard

"Costs incurred by State Advisory Councils or Committees established pursuant to Federal requirements to carry out grant programs are allowable. The cost of like organizations is allowable when provided for in the grant agreement."

(c) Allocable Services

The administration of programs and funds authorized by the State Legilature are allocable. The administration of federal grant program are allocable. Research beneficial to State education agencies is allocable if it is not supported by federal funds.

(d) Allocation Base

Allocations are made to higher education institutions based upon student enrollments.

NEGOTIATION AGREEMENT

STATE/LOCAL-WIDE COST ALLOCATIONS

DATE November 30, 1977

STATE/LOCALITY:

State of Minnesota St. Paul, Minnesota 55155 FILING REG.: This replaces Negotiation Agreement dated June 10, 1976

Pursuant to General Services Administration FMC-74-4, the Department of Health, Education, and Welfare approves the central service costs cited in this agreement. This approval is subject to the conditions contained in Section III.

SECTION I: COSTS DISTRIBUTED THROUGH STATE/LOCAL-WIDE COST ALLOCATIONS

The central service costs listed in Exhibit A, attached, are approved on a Fixed basis for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1978 and may be included as part of the costs of the departments/agencies indicated in Exhibit A for further allocation to Federal grants and contracts performed by the respective departments/agencies.

SECTION II: COSTS DISTRIBUTED THROUGH BILLING MECHANISMS

In addition to the costs distributed through State/local-wide cost allocations cited in Section I, the costs of the central services listed below may be billed to user departments/agencies:

Direct charges from the above centers will be billed in accordance with rates established by the State and recorded on the books of the operating agency responsible for providing the services. Department/agency indirect cost rate proposals must clearly identify costs that have been distributed through billing mechanisms as-well-as costs included in Section I of this Agreement.

SECTION III: GENERAL

- A. LIMITATIONS: Use of the amounts contained in this agreement are subject to any statutory or administrative limitations and when ultimately allocated to individual grants or contracts through the indirect cost rates of each State/local department/agency, are applicable only to the extent that funds are available. Acceptance of the amounts agreed to herein is predicated on the conditions: (1) that no costs other than those incurred by the State/locality were included for distribution in it State/local-wide cost allocation plan as finally accepted and that such costs are legal obligations of the State/locality and allowable under the governing cost principles, (2) that similar types of costs have been accorded consistent accounting treatment, (3) that the information provided by the State/locality which was used as the basis for acceptance of the amounts or rates agreed to herein is not subsequently found to be materially incomplete or inaccurate.
- B. CHANGES: If fixed or predetermined amounts are contained in this agreement, they are based on the organizational structure and the accounting system in effect at the time the plan was prepared and the agreement was negotiated. These amounts are subject to modification if changes are made in the organizational structure or in the method of accounting for costs which affect the amount of reimbursement resulting from use of the amounts. The authorized representative of the responsible negotiation agency must be notified of such changes prior to their effective date. Failure to provide this notification may result in subsequent cost disallowances.
- C. FIXED AMOUNTS: If fixed amounts are contained in this agreement, they are based on an estimate of the costs that will be incurred during the period to which the amounts apply. When the actual costs for such period are determined, adjustments will be made in a subsequent negotiation to compensate for the differences between the costs used to establish the fixed amounts and the actual costs.
- D. BILLED COSTS: Charges for the services cited in Section II will be billed in accordance with rates established by the State/Locality and recorded on the books of the operating department/agency responsible for providing the services. Such charges will be based on the actual, allowable costs, as defined in FMC 74-4, incurred by the operating department/agency responsible for providing the services. Variances resulting from differences between billed allowable costs and the actual allowable costs for a particular accounting period will be compensated for by adjusting the rates in a subsequent accounting period.
- E. NOTIFICATION TO FEDERAL AGENCIES: Copies of this document may be provided to other Federal agencies as a means of notifying them of the agreement contained herein.
