This document displays the Fund Statements for the 1998-99 biennium as well as the historical years presented in the budget documents. The Fund Statements do not represent the state's official financial report, but rather are prepared as a supplement to the budget document. These statements are designed to summarize and display comparative budget data by fund for the budget period. They are prepared to highlight the financial decisions considered in developing the biennial budget recommendations.

It should be recognized that revenue, expenditure, transfer and fund balance information in these statements may differ from those in the state's GAAP based Comprehensive Annual Financial Report. This occurs primarily because of differences in the recognition of accruals, reimbursements, deferred revenue, intrafund transactions and the budgetary basis of accounting for encumbrances. In the modified accrual basis used in the Comprehensive Annual financial Report, expenditures are recognized when goods or services are received regardless of the year encumbered. In the budget system and in these fund statements, encumbrances are recognized as expenditures in the year encumbered.

Fund statements are presented for the following classification of funds:

General Fund	Accounts for all financial resources except those required to be accounted for in another fund.
Special Revenue Funds	Accounts for the proceeds of specific revenue sources (other than expendable trusts or for major capital projects) that are legally restricted to expenditure for specific purposes.
Expendable Trust Funds	Fiduciary funds which account for funds whose resources, including principal and interest, may be expended.
Debt Service Fund	Accounts for the accumulation of resources for, and the payment of, most general obligation long-term debt principal and interest.

The fund statements do not include all funds presented in the Annual Financial Report. Comparative and projected data for these non-operating funds, because of their specialized nature, does not provide meaningful information in the budgetary fund statement format. Financial statements for these funds can be found in the Comprehensive Annual Financial Report for the years ending June 30, 1995 and June 30, 1996.

The table of contents for the fund statements is on the following page. A list of the funds not included in this document, with corresponding page numbers in the Comprehensive Financial Reports, is in the appendix.

Copies of the state's Comprehensive Annual Financial Report may be obtained by contacting the Financial Reporting Division in the Department of Finance.
