While all outlets listed here sell Minnesota products, some may also sell products from outside the state. Consumers should ask whether the produce they are buying is "Minnesota grown".

Every attempt has been made to locate farmers' markets, roadside stands, and pick-your-own farms, but some may have been missed. BELTRAMI COUNTY

- Hennings Gardens** - On-farm sales outlet located 3 miles northwest of Debs. (From junction of County Road 5 and 32, go 1 mile west on 32.) Open 10 a.m. to 7 p.m., daily, from July to October 1. Call 218/243-2851 before driving to farm. Bring your own containers. Peas, carrots, broccoli, cauliflower, corn, beans, rutabagas, squash, cucumbers, peppers, tomatoes, potatoes, eggs, milk, and lambs.
- Lahman's Vegetable Stand** - 17 miles north of Bemidji on Highway 71. Open 10 a.m. to 6 p.m., Monday through Saturday, from June to freeze. Call 218/586-2020. Vegetables and berries.
- North Country Farmers' Market** - Farmers' market located on the Beltrami County Fairgrounds on Paul Bunyan Drive N.W. (Highway 197) on west edge of Bemidji. Open 9 a.m. to 1 p.m., Wednesdays and Saturdays, August 1 to mid-October. Call 218/751-6177. Fresh, locally grown fruits, vegetables and honey.
- Pine Country Produce** - Pick-your-own farm near Solway. Opens in spring. Customer visits are by appointment only. Call 218/467-3293 before coming to farm. Strawberries and raspberries.

CARLTON COUNTY

- Randy Bergh's Family Farm** - Roadside stand and pick-your-own farm located 7 miles southwest of Carlton on Gillogly Road. Open 8 a.m. to 6 p.m., Monday through Saturday, from July 1 to November 1. All produce is organically grown. Call 218/384-3269 before coming to farm. Strawberries, raspberries, picklers, dill, carrots, green and yellow beans, tomatoes, sweet corn, cabbage, broccoli, cauliflower, onions, potatoes, pumpkins, squash, and beets.
- Fruit Basket and Nursery** - Pick-your-own farm located 5 miles south of Carlton on County Road 4. Opens June 20. Call 218/384-4159 for picking days and hours. Pick-your-own raspberries and strawberries. Nursery stock and perennial flowers available during growing season.
- Marshall's Strawberry Farm** - Pick-your-own farm is 6 miles west of Barnum on County Road 6. Open 8 a.m. to 6 p.m., daily, from late June to early August. Call 218/389-6140 to make sure berries are available before driving to farm. Bring your own containers. Strawberries.
- North Road Berry Farm** - Pick-your-own farm located in Cloquet city limits on North Road. Opens July 4 for three weeks and reopens in mid-August. Open daily from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m., weather permitting. Call 218/879-7873 before coming to farm. Strawberries in July and raspberries in August.

CLEARWATER COUNTY

- A & F Produce** - Roadside stand and pick-your-own farm is located 1 1/2 miles west of Shevlin on Highway 2. Pick-your-own raspberries season is July 15 to 30. No children under age 15 allowed to pick raspberries. Roadside stand is open August 1 to October 15, daily, from 1 to 7 p.m. Stand has peas, beans, cucumbers, cabbage, carrots, cauliflower, tomatoes, peppers, potatoes, pumpkins, squash, corn, kohlrabi, onions, gourds, radishes, broccoli, rutabagas, dill, and beets. Call 218/785-2274. After August 1, call 218/785-2128.

COOK COUNTY

- Cook County Farmers' Market** - Located on Cook County Fairgrounds in Grand Marais. Open 10 a.m. to noon, Fridays, from June to October. Fresh fruits and vegetables, honey, maple syrup, plants, and flowers.

ITASCA COUNTY

- Grandma's Raspberry Patch** - Pick-your-own farm is located 6 miles south of Grand Rapids on Highway 169 and 4 miles southeast on LaPlant Road. Open daily by appointment from early July to early September. Call 218/326-6855 before driving to farm. No children under 12 allowed to pick raspberries.
- Knute's Fruits** - Pick-your-own farm is located 6 miles south of Grand Rapids on Highway 169 and 4 miles east on LaPlant Road. Open 8:30 a.m. to noon, Monday through Saturday, from late June to mid-July. Call 218/326-5719 for directions and reservations. Bring your own flat boxes. No children under 12 allowed to pick strawberries.
- Pinecrest Plantations** - Pick-your-own farm located 2 miles south of Blackberry on Township Road C. Opens in July. Call 218/326-5965 (after 5 p.m.) before coming to farm. Strawberries.

KOOCHICING COUNTY

- Althison's Produce Farm** - Roadside stand is located 10 miles south of International Falls on Highway 53. Follow signs on Highway 53. Open 8 a.m. to 8 p.m., daily, from early July to late September. Call 218/377-4322 to check on produce availability. Sweet corn and potatoes. If season is good, cucumbers and tomatoes, too.
- Donahue's Farm** - Farm located 2 miles southwest of International Falls on County Road 106. Open 8 a.m. to 1 p.m., daily, from early August to September 10. Call 218/283-4111. Sweet corn and lawn sod.
- Hoge's Farm Market** - Located on Highway 71 at Littlefork River bridge. Open 9 a.m. to 5 p.m., Mondays, Wednesdays, Fridays, and Saturdays, year-round. Call 218/278-6704. Fresh fruit and produce in season, eggs, chickens, livestock, and organic and natural foods.

MAHNOMEN COUNTY

- River Bend Ranch** - Market and pick-your-own farm is 8 miles east of Mahanomen on Highway 200 and 1 mile north on County Road 3. Open 9 a.m. to 9 p.m., daily, year-round. Also beach, picnic area, and fishing. Accepts food stamps. Call 218/935-5757. Organically grown fruits and vegetables in season.
- Trading Post** - Sales outlet located 11 miles east of Waubun at the junction of Highway 113 and Snyder Lake Road. Open 10 a.m. to 5 p.m., Friday through Sunday, from May to September. Call 218/473-2318. Garden produce in season. Also a sporting goods store.

NORMAN COUNTY

- Kerlin's Berry Farm** - Roadside stand located southeast of Ada. Go 1 mile south on Highway 9 and 1 mile east. Open 10 a.m. to 8 p.m., daily, from June 15 to October 1. Call 218/784-4384. Strawberries, raspberries, corn, potatoes, squash, pumpkins, onions, and carrots.
- Valley Produce** - Roadside stand and pick-your-own farm located in Halstad on Highway 75. Open 9 a.m. to 6 p.m., Monday through Saturday, from early July to November 1. Call 218/456-2566. Corn, potatoes, tomatoes, dry beans, carrots, apples, cucumbers, beets, pumpkins, onions, muskmelons, cabbage, squash, peppers, and watermelons.

POLK COUNTY

- Jerry's Berry Farm** - Pick-your-own farm located 4 1/2 miles east of Crookston on County Road 11. Open 9 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday through Saturday, June 25 to July 15. Call 218/281-6693. Children must be supervised and no pets allowed in fields. Strawberries.
- U-Pik Berry Patch** - Pick-your-own farm located in Winger on Highway 59. Open 7 a.m. to 1 p.m., Mondays, Wednesdays, and Saturdays beginning June 15. Call 218/938-4169 before driving to farm. Strawberries and raspberries.

ST. LOUIS COUNTY

- Duluth Farmers' Market** - Located at 14th Avenue East and Third Street in Duluth. Open 7 a.m. to noon, Wednesdays and Saturdays, from May 15 to November 10. Call 218/724-9955. Fresh vegetables, raspberries, and bedding plants in season.
- Ehlund's Produce** - Roadside stand located 7 miles south of Biwabik on County Road 4. Open 10 a.m. to 8 p.m., daily, from July to September. Call 218/865-6561. Cauliflower, broccoli, corn, potatoes, peas, carrots, beets, and more.

- 25. Ernie's Acres** - On-farm market located 12 miles northeast of Duluth on Lundquist Road. Open 8 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday through Saturday, April 1 through late September. Call 218/525-3370 before driving to farm (except April through late June). Bedding plants, rose plants, nursery stock, and vegetables in season.
- 26. Gordy's Farm Market** - Located at 2999 Miller Trunk Highway in Duluth. Open 9:30 a.m. to 8 p.m., daily, from April 15 to December 30. Call 218/722-8666. Fruits, vegetables, plants, shrubs, and Christmas trees in season.
- 27. Greens From Greaney** - Pick-your-own farm is located 9 miles west of Gheen and 2 miles north of the Greaney Store. Open 8 a.m. to 8 p.m., daily, from May 15 to October 1. Call before coming to farm. Call 218/787-2253 at 7 a.m. or between 9 and 10 p.m. Asparagus, corn, tomatoes, squash, peas, raspberries, beets, carrots, broccoli, onions, lettuce, cabbage, cauliflower, beans, and bedding plants.
- 28. Halden Farm & Greenhouse** - Roadside stand located 5 miles west of Floodwood on County Road 832. In May and June bedding plants are available on Tuesday through Sunday from 9 a.m. to noon and 4 to 9 p.m. Farm produce (tomatoes, hot and sweet peppers, onions, cabbage, potatoes and herbs) are available between late July to late September. Call before driving to farm to check on produce availability. Call 218/476-2829 early in the morning or in the evening. Children must be supervised and no pets allowed.
- 29. Hibbing Farmers' Market** - Located on the St. Louis County Fairgrounds at the intersection of Highway 169 and 25th Street in Hibbing. Open 10 a.m. to 2 p.m., Fridays, from May 27 through early October. Fruits, vegetables, bedding plants, honey, crafts, and baked goods.
- 30. Hill-N-Dale Farm** - Roadside stand and pick-your-own farm located at 4032 Hermantown Road, ¼ mile from Duluth city limits. Open 10 a.m. to 9 p.m., daily, from July 15 to October 15. Call 218/727-7739. Squash, tomatoes, cauliflower, potatoes, cucumbers, and sweet corn in season.
- 31. Lakewood Barrifarm** - Pick-your-own farm located 5 miles north of Duluth near intersection of Riley Road and [unclear] Road. Call 218/525-2051 before driving to farm. Raspberries.
- 32. Stonybrook Greenhouse & Gardens** - Roadside stand located ½ mile south and ½ mile west of Brookston on Highway 2. Open 9 a.m. to 8 p.m., daily, from May 1 to October 1. Call 218/453-5659. Bedding plants, hanging baskets, and homegrown vegetables in season.
