




About This Directory

This directory is not an endorsement by the Minnesota Department of Agriculture of any of the farms, markets, or roadside stands listed here. These outlets have indicated that they sell Minnesota grown fruits, vegetables, cheese, honey, and/or eggs. Not all of these products are available at every outlet. Some outlets may also sell meat, bedding plants, fish, processed foods, handicraft, or other items outside the scope of this directory. While all outlets here sell Minnesota produce, some may also sell produce from outside the state. Consumers should ask whether the produce they are buying is "Minnesota grown."

Every attempt has been made to locate farmers' markets, roadside stands, orchards, and pick-your-own farms, but some may have been missed. If you know of any farm outlet that sells produce directly to consumers, please contact the Marketing and International Trade Division, Minnesota Department of Agriculture, 90 West Plato Boulevard, St. Paul, MN 55107.

Beans, cabbage, broccoli, cauliflower, sweet corn, green peppers, pumpkins, squash, tomatoes, watermelons, muskmelons and honey.

- 41. **Slayton Area Chamber of Commerce Farmers' Market** - Located at 26th St., off Broadway in Slayton. Open 5 to 9 p.m., Thursdays, from late July to freeze. Call 507/836-6902. Home grown fruits and vegetables.
- 42. **Stonegate Orchard** - Roadside stand located 1-1/2 miles north of Slayton on Highway 59. Open 1 p.m. to 6 p.m., Friday through Sunday, from August 29 to end of apple season. Call 507/836-6918. Ten varieties of apples including Beacon, Wealthy, McIntosh, Red Baron, Haralson, Honeygold, Cortland, Regent, Connell Red and Fireside.

NICOLLET COUNTY

- 43. **Albrecht's Vegetables** - On-farm sales outlet located 2 miles west of North Mankato, then 1-1/2 miles south on Township Road 125. Open 10 a.m. to 7 p.m., daily, July to frost. Call 507/625-8428. Cucumbers, beans, green and hot peppers, tomatoes, sweet corn, melons, squash, cabbage, pumpkins, egg plants and herbs.

NOBLES COUNTY

- 44. **Nystrom Brothers Fruit Farm** - Roadside stand and pick-your-own farm located 6 miles south of Worthington on County Road 5. Open 9 a.m. to 8 p.m., daily, from August 1 to November 1. Call 507/376-4556. The original Nystrom Brothers Fruit Farm in business since 1907. Homegrown apples, plums and locally grown honey.

- 31. **Welch Honey Farms** - On-farm sales outlet located 6 miles southeast of Le Center on County Road 11, then 2 miles on County Road 2 to Cordova. Open 8 a.m. to 8 p.m., daily, from August 2 to November 2. Call 612/357-6764. Fresh, raw strained honey and comb honey.

LINCOLN COUNTY

- 32. **Andersen Honey** - Self-serve roadside stand located 5 miles north of Lake Benton on Highway 75. Open year-round. Call 507/368-4593. Honey.

LYON COUNTY

- 33. **Shady Acres** - Roadside stand located at the east end of Ghent on Highway 68. Open 8 a.m. to dark, daily, from June to October 31. Call 507/428-3495. Sign in front tells what is available each day. Apples, plums, cider, strawberries, potatoes, sweet corn and squash.

MARTIN COUNTY

- 34. **Harnden's Market** - Roadside stand and pick-your-own farm located at 1913 Albion Avenue, Fairmont (south on old Highway 16). Stand is open 10 a.m. to 6 p.m., daily, from June 10 to August 10. Pick-your-own is open 7 a.m. to noon. Call 507/235-3169 before driving to farm. Children under 11 are not allowed in fields. Strawberries, raspberries and sweet corn. Only strawberries are pick-your-own.

- 35. **Harris Farms Honey** - Roadside stand located 1 mile south and 1 mile west of Trimont. Open 8 a.m. to 10 p.m., daily, year-round. Call 507/375-7281, 375-3341 or 639-6413. One-hundred percent pure Grade A, fancy honey (liquid and comb).

MC LEOD COUNTY

- 36. **Broman Vegetable Farm** - On-farm sales outlet located 4 miles west of Winsted off County Road 56 on County Road 31. Open sunrise to sunset, daily, from May 1 to June 15 and July 30 to heavy frost. Call 612/485-4197 before driving to farm to ensure produce is available. Only tomatoes are pick-your-own. Bedding plants, cabbage, cauliflower, squash, tomatoes, peppers, watermelon, muskmelon, cucumbers, Brussels sprouts and sweet corn in season.

- 37. **Maple Crest Berry Farm** - Pick-your-own farm located 1-3/4 miles north of Silver Lake on gravel road coming off paved County Road 16. Open 8

BLUE EARTH COUNTY

- 1. Flitter's Cheesehouse** - Roadside stand located 5 miles south of Madelia on Highway 15. (Take Fairmont exit, left on County Road 26, 3 miles east and 1/2 mile north.) Open daily, year-round. Call 507/642-8457. Tours available upon request. Farmstead cheese (gouda, caraway, baby Swiss) and sweetcorn.
- 2. Hoehn Nursery** - Roadside stand and pick-your-own farm located 1/4 mile west of Madison Lake on Highway 60. Open 8 a.m. to 7 p.m., daily, from June 1 to August 15. Call 507/243-3843 before driving to farm. No children allowed to pick without parent supervision. Strawberries and raspberries.
- 3. Kopischke Kid's Market** - Roadside stand and pick-your-own farm located 1/2 mile south of Vernon Center on Highway 169. Open 9 a.m. to 8 p.m., daily, from August 1 to November 1. Call 507/549-3313. Pick-your-own vegetables available earlier in season than at stand. Melons, pumpkins, squash, Indian corn, broccoli, cauliflower, beans, cucumbers, tomatoes, peppers, onions, popcorn, honey, zucchini, cabbage, apples, etc.
- 4. Old Town Plaza Farmers' Market** - Located at Old Town Plaza, North Front Street and Elm Street in Mankato. Open 8 a.m. to noon, Saturdays, from June to September. Also, 4 p.m. to 8 p.m., Tuesdays, later in season. Call 507/388-7871. Garden produce, eggs and honey.
- 5. Smith Berrie Farm** - On-farm sales outlet and pick-your-own farm located 6 miles south of Lake Crystal on Highway 20. Watch for signs. Open 8 a.m. to dark, daily, from mid-June to frost. Call 507/546-3823. Only strawberries are pick-your-own. Strawberries, tomatoes, melons, squash and assorted small vegetables.
- 6. Welsh Heritage Farms** - Roadside stand and pick-your-own farm located on Highway 60 between Lake Crystal and Mankato. Open daily from July to December. Call 507/726-6562. Raspberries and apples.

BROWN COUNTY

- 7. North Star Seed Farm** - Located 1 mile north and 1-3/4 miles west of Springfield. Open 8 a.m. to 6 p.m., Monday through Saturday, year-round. Call 507/723-4484. Seeds: soybeans, oats, wheat, barley and rye.

CHIPPEWA COUNTY

- 8. Brian's Evergreen Produce** - Roadside stand located 1 1/2 miles east of Montevideo on Highway 7. Open 10 a.m. to 9 p.m., daily, from mid-June to frost. Call 612/269-7395. Large variety of veg-

etables including peas, beans, carrots, onions, cabbage, rhubarb, sweet corn, tomatoes, peppers, squash, cucumbers, pumpkins and potatoes.

- 9. Smith Farm** - Roadside stand and pick-your-own farm located 14 miles west of Willmar on Highway 40, then 3/4 mile north. Open 8 a.m. to 6 p.m., Monday through Saturday, from June to December. Call 612/264-5435 before driving to farm. Bring your own containers. Strawberries, sweet corn, tomatoes, squash, potatoes, gladiolus, pumpkins, cucumbers and muskmelons.

FARIBAULT COUNTY

- 10. Nagel's Orchard** - Roadside stand located 2 1/2 miles east of Winnebago on Highway 109, then 1 mile south on Township Road. Watch for signs on Highways 109 and 169. Open daylight hours, Monday through Saturday, and 1 p.m. to evening, Sundays, from August 20 to November. Call 507/893-3584. Apples, squash and pumpkins.

FILLMORE COUNTY

- 11. Appleberry Farm** - Pick-your-own farm located approximately 9 miles southeast of Chatfield. Follow signs on Highway 30 and County Road 11. Open 8 a.m. to 4 p.m., daily, from approximately June 15 to July 8 for pick-your-own strawberries and through the season for other fruits and vegetables. Call 507/867-4846 (before 8 a.m.) before driving to farm. No children. Strawberries, cut flowers, herbs, vegetables including asparagus, rhubarb, snap beans, sweet corn, tomatoes, peppers and squash.
- 12. Bristol Berry Patch** - Pick-your-own farm located 8 miles west of Harmony on Highway 44, then 1/2 mile north. Open 7 a.m. to dusk, Monday through Saturday, and 1 p.m. to dusk, Sundays, from mid-June to early August and reopens September 1 to hard freeze. Call 507/937-3193 before driving to farm. Strawberries and raspberries.
- 13. Pine Tree Apple Orchard** - Roadside stand located 1/2 mile northeast of Highway 52 in Preston on County Road 17. Open 8 a.m. to 8 p.m., weekdays, and 10 a.m. to 6 p.m., weekends, from August 1 to March 1. Call 507/765-2408. Visitors welcome. Tours available for schools and civic groups. Minnesota apples, apple baked goods, apple cider and honey.

GOODHUE COUNTY

- 17. Red Wing Farmers' Market** - Located on parking lot of Red Wing City Hall on Bush Street, downtown Red Wing. Open 7 a.m. to 1 p.m., Saturdays, from late July through October. Fruits, vegetables, eggs, honey, poultry, rabbits and flowers.
- 18. Red Wing Farm-to-Market Day** - Chamber of Commerce one-day event on downtown Red Wing streets. Open 8 a.m. to 2 p.m., September 10. Locally grown produce and fruits. Call 612/388-4719.

Call 507/652-2233. Fifteen varieties of apples, also honey and Christmas trees.
62. **Northfield Farmers' Market** - Located at Seventh and Linden St., Riverside Park, in Northfield. Open noon until sold out, Tuesdays and Fridays, from late spring to late fall. Call 507/645-8676. Homegrown fruits, vegetables, houseplants and bedding plants.
