## **Aggregate Information on Advisory Groups**

### **Number of groups**

This study identifies 167 executive branch advisory groups. This number includes only groups created or specifically authorized by the legislature. It does not include groups created by executive order or by action of a commissioner. The number also does not include groups that are so short-term that the legislation creating them was not codified in Minnesota Statutes.

The advisory groups can be categorized as follows:

- ▶ 110 advisory councils and committees mandated by law
- ▶ 28 advisory task forces mandated by law
- ▶ 29 advisory groups specifically authorized by law, but not mandated.

Two prior studies have been done on this issue. A 1982 study identified 79 advisory groups. A 1988 study counted 125 groups.

## **General Laws Governing Advisory Groups**

The legislature has enacted general rules governing advisory groups (Minnesota Statutes, section 15.059). These rules apply only if the law creating an advisory group refers to section 15.059. The general rules in section 15.059 are described below.

### **Names of Groups**

**Councils:** Advisory groups in which at least one-half of the members must be representatives of specified industries, occupations, or other organizations, are called "councils".

**Committees:** Advisory groups in which less than half of the members must be representatives of specified organizations are called "committees".

**Task forces:** Advisory groups scheduled to expire within two years of creation are called "task forces".

### **Membership terms**

Members of **advisory councils and committees** serve four-year terms. The terms of half of the members expire with the term of the governor. The terms of the other half of the members expire the following year. Members of advisory **task forces** serve until the expiration date of the task force (up to two years after the group is created).

### **Removal**

Members may be removed at the pleasure of the appointing authority. Appointing authorities are given special authorization to remove members who miss three consecutive meetings.

### **Compensation**

Members of an advisory group receive compensation and expense reimbursement only if authorized by the law creating the group.

When a law authorizes compensation and expense reimbursement, it usually refers to section 15.059. That section provides that members of advisory **councils and committees** receive \$55 per day spent on group activity, when authorized by the group. Members of advisory **task forces** do not receive this \$55 per day. It is not uncommon for the law creating an advisory group to stipulate that members will not receive the \$55 payment.

The general rules governing expense reimbursement apply to advisory task forces, as well as to councils and committees. Members are reimbursed for meal, travel, hotel, and child care expenses.

## **Expiration**

The 1988 Legislature provided for all advisory **councils and committees** that are governed by section 15.059 to expire on June 30, 1993. As noted in the aggregate information on page 3, this is not really a general rule--there are many groups with no expiration date.

Advisory task forces generally expire two years after their creation. However, the appointing authority generally can appoint a new task force if necessary.
