Adults With Serious and Persistent Mental Illness

Minnesota's public mental health system is administered by the state mental health authority (Department of Human Services) and 87 local mental health authorities (counties). Counties contract with local providers for services to public clients, and offer some services directly to their clients. The Department also provides some direct services, particularly through its regional treatment centers (RTCs).

This report--a collection of tables--summarizes activity in the adult sector of the public mental health system during calendar year 1996. It is intended for use by counties, service providers, state staff, legislators, consumers, advocates, and others.

Each table in this report contains statistical information for a particular service, such as case management and outpatient treatment. Statistics are displayed for each county (county of financial responsibility). The information varies somewhat from table to table, depending on the nature of the service and the way in which service activity can be measured. Statewide information is shown at the bottom of each table, and notes are provided to help readers interpret the meaning of the information in each table column.

Note that for most services the information applies only to adults with serious and persistent mental illness (SPMI). The exceptions are RTC inpatient and community inpatient services, for which data available to the Department do not indicate if the individual has a SPMI. It can be assumed, however, because of this intense level of treatment, that most of these inpatient clients do have a serious and persistent mental illness.

The content of the tables is based on data reported to the Department by counties and their contracted providers. Most of these data are reported

through the Community Mental Health Reporting System (CMHRS); data on RTC and community inpatient clients are obtained through billing systems. In some cases, providers or counties are unable to report data in time for inclusion in this report. In these cases, the statistical information for the counties involved will be low (under-counted). The report does not attempt to cite each of these occurrences, but relies instead on counties to note under-reporting and to ensure that their providers report on schedule.

Another explanation for observed "under-counts" is that reported data found by the Department to be in error may not be corrected by reporting agencies in time for inclusion.

In some cases, where the Department observes an under-count for a service that is billed to the MA system as well as reported through the CMHRS, the Department may substitute the higher MA count.

Note on duplication: In some cases, a client might be counted more than once for a service, if the client received the service from more than one provider. Statewide client counts are sums of the county figures and are not unduplicated across counties.

From your own computer, you can connect to the Department of Human Services mental health databases and obtain immediate information about service utilization and service costs, for any county or provider serving public clients. State statutes, rules, and bulletins are also available.

Can you be more specific?

You will see tables something like what you see in this service utilization report, but you will also be able to "drill-down" to more specific information--for instance, click on your county name in the table and see the information by individual provider. You can also display the information graphically (bar graphs, pie charts, etc.).

The Enterprise Information System (EIS) has information on Medical Assistance utilization and costs, and special survey results, in addition to community program information.

How easy is it to use?

It's based on the familiar "point-and-click" technology, requiring only a few clicks of your mouse button to see the report you want. Help information is available on every screen.
