CIR & Overlay	\$375,000
Reclamation	\$425,000
Total Pavement Replacement	\$500,000
Total Reconstruction – Rural	\$1,000,000
Total Reconstruction – Urban	\$2,000,000






## Pavement Needs 2016 - 2025






## <u>Unfunded</u> cannot be <u>Unpaved</u>
